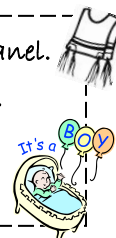

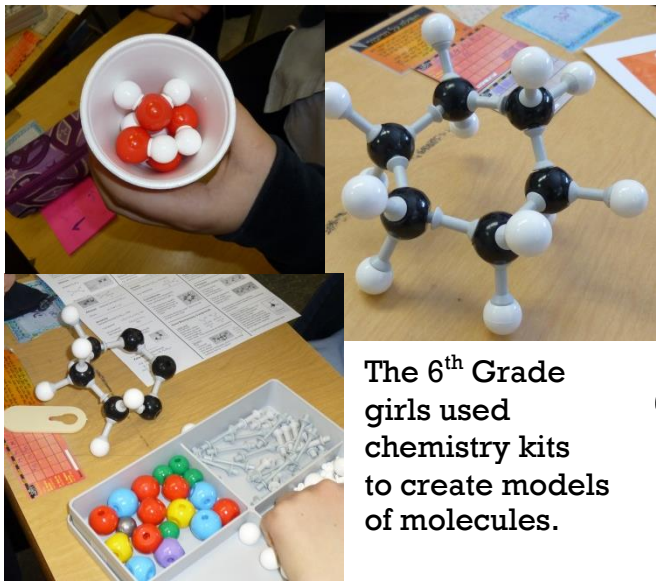

A MESSAGE FROM OUR MENAHEL

Rabbi Yehuda Brecher

”זאת תהיה תורת המצורע ביום טהרתו”

There is a well-known Medrash that brings the story of R' Yannai and the peddler. The peddler would make rounds and announce “Who wants to purchase a portion of life...”. He told R' Yannai “...נצור לשונך מרע...”. R' Yannai said “All my life I said these פסוקים in תהלים and I didn't perceive its simple meaning until this peddler came along and made it known.” The Milchamos Yehuda asks what did the peddler say that R' Yannai didn't know? When the peddler referred to Shmiras Halashon as a “portion of life”, he meant that this quality has the כח to change a person's life. The עבירה of habitual Lashon Hara is different than other עבירות. A person who makes a habit of denigrating others is like a worm that derives its nourishment from rotten food. His life revolves around this עבירה which destroys the אחדות in ישראל. On the other hand, if he is careful with his words and uses his דבור to spread Shalom and lift spirits, it will lift himself as well and he will derive spiritual “sustenance” and give him life.

May we be זוכה to use our speech to bring כבוד שמים to our lives and our families.
