A MESSAGE FROM OUR MENAHEL

Rabbi Yehuda Brecher

"ועשית את הקרשים למשכן עצי שטים עמדים"

"You should make the beams of the משכן of שטים wood."

רשי explains why the תורה uses the letter ה (definitive) before mentioning the beams. The letter ה shows that they were not the standard שטים beams; they were beams specifically designated for this purpose that were constructed from trees that יעקב planted in מצרים for use in future years.

Rav Shalom Schwadron asks: There were other items that were needed for the משכן construction that were not available in the Midbar, and we know נס sent them through a נס (like some of the stones for the Choshen). Why couldn't the same נס have happened with the beams, instead of יעקב toiling to plant the trees in Mitzrayim, and Moshe transporting them to the Midbar?

R' Shalom explains that the משכן contained various items, each unique and special. But the walls, more than anything else, brought about השראת השכינה. The walls that were made of שטים wood defined the parameters of the משכן and made it into a place that was insulated from the outside world. The only way you can have השראת השכינה is through a person's effort and toil, and not through miracles.

Our home, as we all know, is a מקדש מעט, and the only way for it to be the right setting for the שכינה to dwell in it, is through toil and work. May הקדוש ברוך הוא give us the strength to continue to elevate our homes and enable the שכינה to rest there.
